Why attend?

Family leaders will gain knowledge and skills to meaningfully engage as stakeholders in conversations about Part C (early intervention) and Part B 619 (early childhood special education) data. The learning experience will focus on how data can be used as a powerful tool for improving programs and improving outcomes for children and families. Participants will be provided with resources that they can take back to their own states to use with other families.

Who should attend?

Family members who:

- have young children (up to age 8) who have received EI or ECSE services;
- are involved or interested in state and/or local data conversations (including SSIP); and
- have existing networks for sharing resources and knowledge with other families in their state.

What will I have to do?

Accepted participants agree to:

- Fully participate in this two-day Institute with family leaders from other states.
 - *Other participants may include Part C and 619 staff and/or parent center staff.*
- Develop an Action Plan to identify next steps for sharing information with other families within your state.
- Share follow up information with DaSy Center staff about implementing the Action Plan.
