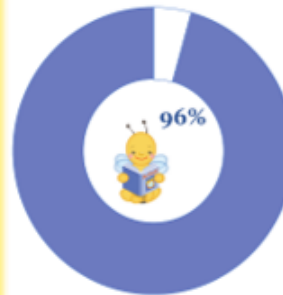


You will know how to help your child develop and learn.

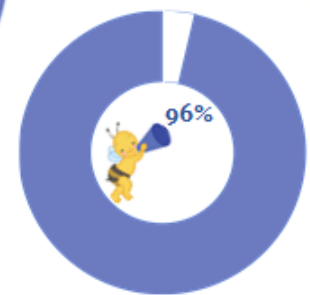
Your service coordinator and team help you find things you can do with your child to help them learn. Practicing activities during everyday routines with family and other caregivers will help your child learn new skills.

Percent of Families who said Early Intervention helped them:

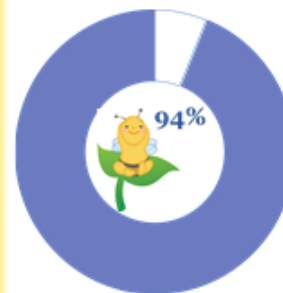
