### What is a Family Data Leader?

Family Data Leaders are skilled data users who can bring their family voice along with an understanding of IDEA, data use, and systems building to inform Part C and Part B 619 program improvement.

### How to Include a Family Data Leader in Your Program

- 1. Know your community:** Identify and connect regularly with family members.
- 2. Include diverse voices:** Invite and seek different views. Prioritize diverse input.
- 3. Build trust and respect:** Take all ideas and recommendations seriously.
- 4. Maintain support:** Provide thoughtful and ongoing mentorship and responsive support.
- 5. Celebrate:** Highlight and share achievements, big and small.

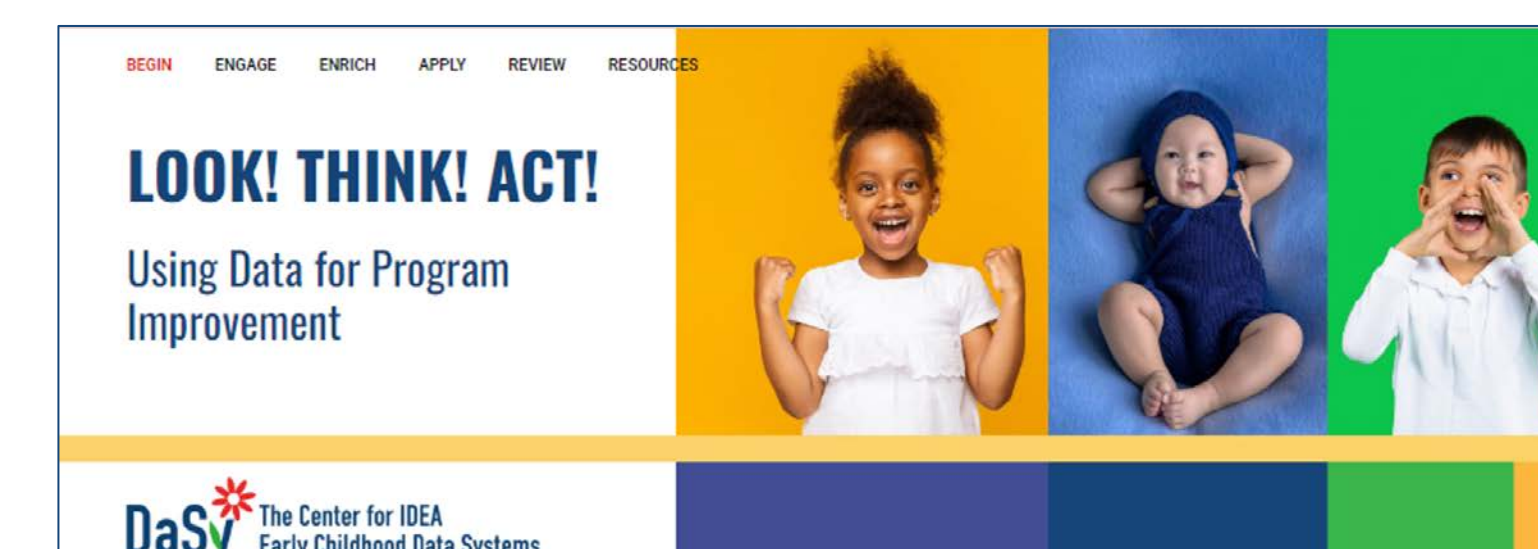

## Spotlight: Child Outcomes

DaSy collaborates with the Early Childhood Technical Assistance Center (ECTA) to provide technical assistance (TA) on measuring and reporting outcomes for young children with disabilities. The outcomes measure children's progress in their use of functional skills across three areas:

- 1. Social Relationships:** getting along with other children and relating well with adults
- 2. Use of Knowledge and Skills:** thinking, reasoning, problem-solving, and early literacy and math skills
- 3. Taking Action to Meet Needs:** feeding, dressing, self-care, and following rules related to health and safety
